### CRITICAL TIME FRAMES RELATED TO ACADEMIC PROCESSES

### **INTRODUCTION**

- 1. Academic related processes are **time-sensitive**; therefore, it is important for the Centre of Studies (CoS) to adhere to the time frame. However, there has been an impression that there is no cut-off dateline from one process to another process.
- 2. This misunderstanding of temporal boundaries between procedural stages appears to contribute to operational inefficiencies and workflow disruption.
- 3. The critical time frames are provided to enable CoS to do proper planning.

#### **GUIDELINES**

- 4. For the establishment of new <u>undergraduate</u> academic programme (Level 5 and Level 6), submission to Jabatan Pendidikan Tinggi (JPT) happens twice:
  - i) Mesyuarat Saringan Awal (MSA): CoS must submit *Permohonan Program untuk Saringan Awal* to KCA within **two (2) months** after Senate endorsement.
  - ii) Jawatankuasa Pendidikan Tinggi (JKPT): After receiving Provisional Accreditation (PA) status, CoS must submit *Permohonan Program Akademik Baru* to KCA within **two (2) months**.
- 5. For the establishment of new <u>postgraduate</u> academic programme (Level 7 and Level 8), upon receiving Provisional Accreditation (PA) status by MQA, CoS must submit *Permohonan Program Akademik Baru* to KCA within **two (2) months** after Board of Governors (BOG) endorsement for submission to JPT.

- 6. Upon obtaining PA status,
  - i) The <u>first student cohort</u> must be enrolled within the **stipulated time frame stated in the JPT approval letter**, which usually is two (2) years. This deadline is binding. Failure to comply will result in the revocation of PA status i.e. the programme is nullified.
  - ii) The Full Accreditation (FA) document (MQA-02) must be submitted at least **six (6) months** prior to the graduation date of the first student cohort or prior to the PA expiry date granted by MQA, whichever comes first.
- 7. For curriculum review and curriculum development, the following time frame is to be observed:
  - i) From AQAC Phase 1 to AQAC Phase 2, the time duration is six (6) months.
  - ii) From AQAC Phase 2 to Senate, the time duration is three (3) months.
  - iii) For programme that requires JKPT approval following a curriculum review, the *Dokumen Semakan* must be submitted to JPT within **two (2) months** after Senate endorsement. The revised curriculum can only be implemented upon receiving approval from JKPT.
- 8. Adherence to the time frames is necessary to avoid adverse consequences.
